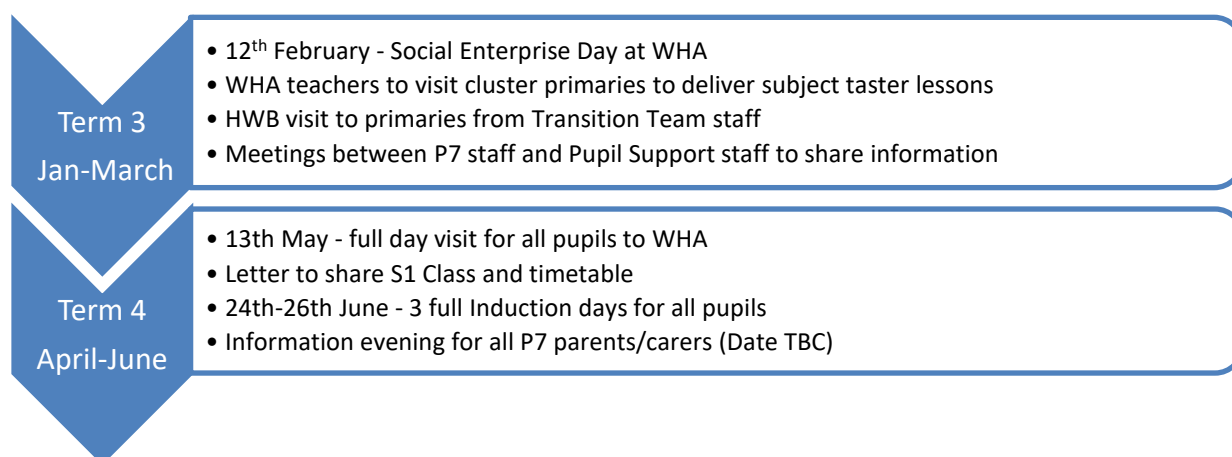

Transport

What to wear, bring and eat

Pupils should wear their usual school uniform and bring a suitable snack and water to have during morning break times.

Lunchtime will be just before WHA's normal lunch time, giving pupils an opportunity to experience the canteen, where they can buy a meal deal for £2.20 or bring their own packed lunch. Unfortunately we cannot transfer any credit that is already on your child's primary account so please provide money unless you are entitled to a Free School Meal. **Free School Meals will be provided for those pupils who normally receive them.**

Medical information

During these visits it is vital that all medical equipment should be with your child e.g. epi-pen/inhaler/diabetic testing kit. **Please ensure that your child has their specific medical essentials in their school bag for their transition days, and that they are all in date.**

Sharing Information

Please contact your primary school **by Tuesday 27th January** if your child will be unable to attend. We still have a record of the information that you shared about your child prior to their visit in October, please contact our school office if you would like to update any of the contact, medical or personal details for your child.

Your child's primary school will also share information prior to the visit regarding specific learning, health and wellbeing information.
