#### **Reporting and Parents' Evenings**

#### **Study Support Programme**

Prelims for pupils in S4, S5 and S6 will take place between **Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> January and Friday 31<sup>st</sup> January 2025.** Although the results of these can no longer be used to appeal against an SQA result, **they remain very important assessments** which give a strong indication of a student's strengths and weaknesses, and their likelihood of success in the final exams. Thorough revision and preparation is important in ensuring that students perform well in their prelims.

Learners will receive advice and guidance from subject teachers about the best ways to carry out study and revision at home for specific subjects. By the senior phase, students need to accept a share of responsibility for their own learning and an essential part of this involves regular study at home. To help our students, we are once again running our study support programme so we can offer lunchtime and after-school support throughout the year. You should have already received a separate letter giving full details of the extensive study support opportunities on offer for all students. Details of all after-school and lunchtime sessions are also published on the school website in the Academy section, and we would encourage all students in S4, S5 and S6 to take up the extra support our teachers are providing for them each week. This is attached at the end of this letter for your information.

If you have a subject specific concern or query about prelims or Study Support, please do not hesitate to contact the appropriate Principal Teacher, the PT Pupil Support with responsibility for your child's house, or a Depute Head Teacher.
