

Illness/absence

Although it is not compulsory for a child to attend ELC, we still require to be informed if your child will not be in, please confirm the reason and when you expect them to be return. This is in line with our Duty of Care as practitioners. Please ask a member of staff if you would like to see any of our policies relating to this. We ask that you follow these to ensure your child is fit and well to be attending the ELC.

Can we also ask that you make us aware of anything your child may have even if there is no isolation period for it, such as head lice. Such things can spread quickly in an environment such as the ELC, so it's really important we are aware.

Weekly plans in the ELC.

We have decided to incorporate an element into each day of the week. These elements will change termly to ensure your child will experience them all depending on their days in ELC. These will be as follows;

Movement Monday – Starting the week off with lots of energetic activities in the gym hall, the garden or even the woods!

Trip Tuesday – We will be taking small groups of children out most weeks to new places relating to the children's current interests. A different group will go each time until everyone has had a turn, and as mentioned this will change termly to ensure all children get to take part.

Wellbeing Wednesday – On a Wednesday we will be focussing on gross motor development, so using lots of bikes, scooters, movements to encourage coordination and lots more!

To the woods Thursday – Mrs Marchbank and Mrs Clingen recently completed a Forest Kindergarten course. We will be taking the children out in blocks to do this, so by the end of the academic year each child will have taken part in this.

Feel Good Friday – On a Friday we would like to look at our mission to become more sustainable. We will be completing our recycling for the week, caring for our garden and surrounding environment, and discussing how we can become more eco-friendly at home.

Focus Weeks

At Wallace Hall ELC, we follow a blended Frobelian and 'Planning in the moment' pedagogy. The purpose of this approach is for children to explore their environment, and when they spark an interest, the practitioner takes the opportunity to support their next steps.

As part of this, we have a focus week, usually once a term, for each child. During a two week period we complete observations and then share this with you in a scheduled meeting the following week. We then discuss progress and next steps, as well as any concerns you may have.

You will receive a letter a week in advance, which gives you an opportunity to share any thoughts ahead of your child's focus week.

Parental Engagement and Home Links

Lending Library

At the front entrance of the ELC, we have a lending library. Children are welcome to borrow a book for up to 2 weeks, which can be recorded in the yellow folder.

Story sacks

Every week, a selection of children will come home with a story sack. The story sacks will contain a book, along with resources to support it, such as a puppet, game or puzzle. Every child will have at least 1 story sack per term, if not 2 depending on the length of the term.

PEEP (Families learning together) sessions and Bookbug sessions – These sessions will be starting in the next few weeks, look out for more information soon!

ELC Uniform

Uniform order forms are available in the cloakroom. Our uniform is optional, and was introduced following feedback from parents/carers.

If you have any uniform that no longer fits/no one to pass down to, we would be happy to take these as we hope to start our own swap shop in the future.


